**TAMAYO**



Without question, Chardonnay is one of the finest white wines. It retains great versatility in style and flavor. This offering of Tamayo Chardonnay presents a sensual array of aromas and flavors reflective of the cool Sonoma estates where it is grown. Vibrant fruit with modest oak ageing preserves this wine's delicious vibrancy and cool fruit flavors.

Vibrant aromas of fresh pear, honeydew melon and citrus fruit are framed by a hint of vanilla spice. On entry of the palate this Chardonnay is fresh and mouth filling and the flavors of pear and nectarine meld on the palate. The acidity emerges only at the finish where it brightens and cleanses the palate.
