Our vintage Port is inspired by the pioneering settlers of Contra Costa County who planted grapes here over 100 years ago. When this area was settled by the Portuguese and other Europeans, their penchant for Port came with them. We have crafted a vintage Port that we think those pioneering vignerons would have enjoyed. This inspired dessert wine is comprised of the classic Portuguese variety Tinta Cao along with the uniquely lush Alicante Bouschet and a touch of Petite Sirah.

Our second grandson, Jeremy Jaden, graces the label of our most cellar-worthy wine. Both hold the promise of many sweet memorable years of future enjoyment.
